


- Food and drinks are as expensive as in Denmark.

- Think outside the box!


# Availability and agreement details

- Typically very specific agreements schools/ departments/ faculties
- Check course restrictions
  - Undergraduate/ graduate level
  - Courses in English
  - Language requirements
- Number of exchange spots differ greatly some 10-50 pr. semester

others 1-3 pr. semester

### DTU**StudyAbroad**

Technical University of Denmark



- You must be enrolled at DTU at the time you apply
- You must complete a minimum of 110 ECTS before departure
- You are expected to take 20-30 ECTS abroad
- You must be actively studying during your study abroad
- An exchange stay must be incorporated in your general study plan!

### **Online application on Beyond Borders**

- Your transcript (karakterudskrift)
- A GPA Calculation Sheet
- Language proficiency documentation if needed

### The next deadline is December 1

Online Application Workshop November 22

### Important things to keep in mind

- You can apply for as many priorities as you want
- Only apply for places you really want to go to and have researched well
- Once you are selected, you will <u>not be able</u> change your destination!
