Why?

- Boost your CV
- Experience new academic approaches
- Improve your language skills
- Build an international network
- Experience and learn to adapt to a new culture
- Get the experience of a lifetime!



Who?

- *All DTU students have the option of studying abroad!*
- *“Do I need a very good GPA?”*
 - *Not necessarily DTU has many exchange places without GPA requirements*
 - *However, some places have requirements or are very popular*
- *“Is it a lot of work?”*
 - *Team up with a fellow student and work together*
 - *Students returning say: It is 100% worth it!*



When?

Who and when?

BSc:

- *5th and/or 6th semester*

BEng:

- *5th or 6th semester*
- *Internship*

MSc:

- *1st, 2nd or 3rd semester*

Planning your stay:

- *Start early: approx. 1 year before you go!*
- *Be aware of DTU application deadlines!*



Where can I go?

- DTU has around 120 partner institutions worldwide

- *Close to DK or far away? (Culture shock, family /relationship ties)*
- *Career building or personal growth?*
- *Visa considerations (e.g. citizenship)*
- *Budget / Financial matters (SU, scholarships)*



Exchange and finance

Income

- No tuition fee
- You can (usually) bring your SU
- Erasmus+ grant
- External funding/ private scholarships

It all depends on where you go and your spending habits 😊

Expenses

- Plane ticket
- Accommodation and living costs
- Books
- Insurance
- Administrative fees
- Visa fees, etc.

Study Abroad in Fall 2023

Deadlines

1st application round:
December 1, 2022

2nd application round:
February 1, 2023

- Late and incomplete applications will not be considered!
- Online Application Workshop:
November 22

Requirements

- *Be enrolled at DTU at the time you apply*
- *Complete a minimum of 110 ECTS of university studies before departure*
- *You must be actively studying during your time abroad*
- *Enrol in and transfer 20-30 ECTS abroad*
- *An exchange stay must be incorporated into your general study plan!*

Apply online and upload

- Transcript (karakterudskrift)
- GPA Calculation Sheet
- Language proficiency documentation, if required

How to prepare your application?

- *You can apply for any destination on DTU Beyond Borders!*


But be aware of the agreement details:

- *Is it university wide? Or with a specific faculty/school/department?*
- *Undergraduate or at graduate level?*
- *How many courses do they have in English?*
- *Are there enough relevant courses for me in the agreement?*

Application priorities

- *You may apply for as many agreements as you want*
- *You only get one offer*
- *Do your research well:*
 - *Once selected you cannot change your priorities/destination*
 - *If you cancel your exchange position, it will be lost*

So, only apply for exchange agreements that you really want!
